Application period

15.02 - 15.03. for the winter semester

Applications are only accepted within the application period. Only the date the application is received is decisive not the postmark. In case the last day of the application deadline is a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday the application deadline is extended to the next working day.

4 semesters (full-time) or 6 semesters (part-time)

Structure of Studies

The study programme Art in Context addresses those who want to work artistically within different social circumstances.

The programme offers 4 modules aiming at different occupational areas:

1. Artistic work with social groups
2. Artistic work within cultural institutions (with the focus areas: Artistic Museum Studies and Artistic Curatorial Studies)
3. Artistic work within the public space
4. Artistic work in the context of media and scientific image production

Entrance requirements

- Graduation certificate from an artistic-creative course of study at a state higher education institution
- Artistic talent
- At least one year working experience in a relevant professional field
- Sufficient knowledge of German

Documents to be submitted with application

- Printout of the online application form (signed).
- CV in tabular form providing detailed information on previous studies, artistic career, professional experience and other qualifications
- Certificate of university graduation; foreign certificates have to be handed in as certified translation (German or English)
- Foreign university degrees must be recognised by uni-assist before the application at UdK Berlin. The uni-assist certificate ("Vorprüfungsdokumentation/VPD") has to be submitted together with the complete application documents to UdK-Berlin. Detailed information can be found here:

- Applicants from the People's Republic of China, Vietnam and Mongolia have to pass a special visa procedure. Please get in contact with the Academic Evaluation Centre (APS), which is attached to the German Embassy, in good time before the application. Detailed information and the forms can be found on the respective homepage.
- For applicants without a university degree exceptions can be made if they have gained the necessary qualifications on the job. The recognition of these qualifications will be tested in a separate aptitude test. Candidates will have to prove at least 3 years of intensive artistic professional practice as part of a full-time job. Possible working areas could be: art, design and conceptual practices in these fields.
- Where applicable: documentation of courses completed and examinations taken
- Samples of work (file, portfolio, maximum DIN A3)
- Statement of motivation for taking the course; outline of study project
- Proof of knowledge of German:
At the time of application: proof of linguistic ability equivalent to level B1
At the time of matriculation: proof of linguistic ability equivalent to level C1

Applications can be sent by post. It's not possible to send applications by fax or email.

Please note: If sending your portfolio by international post with a customs declaration, please make sure that it is declared as application documents (no value given). Portfolios that incur German customs duty and require customs clearance are not collected for cost reasons.
